

Strategic Partner Incentive:

Contracts received between Oct 1, 2022 and January 31, 2023 for events happening in the 2023 calendar year receive 5% incentive pricing applied prior to the Volume Incentive.

For Example: \$100,000 contract booked on Dec 31st would receive a 5% incentive discount, brining reducing the invoice to \$95,000, and then a 3% volume incentive further reducing the invoice to \$92,150.

Volume Incentive:

Volume incentives applied to total gross spend on events being held in the 2023 calendar year.

For example, a contract for \$100,000 receives a 4% incentive. A contract for \$400,000 receives a 12% incentive.

Additional Spend:

Sponsors can add to their total sponsorship package throughout 2023 and be pushed into the next incentive tier. However, incentives are not retroactive to previously contracted events.
